**Rules of Play:**

This is a gross and net competition and the four competitors will play as a team.

Each competitor will tee off and the team will choose the best positioned ball. All four competitors will mark, lift, clean, and place their ball within one club length of the best positioned ball, but not nearer the hole. After playing from the best positioned tee shot, each competitor will then play their own ball for the remainder of the hole. When measuring the club length, competitors may not measure the ball from out of a penalty area, bunker, from out of bounds, from the rough to fairway/ fringe, or onto the putting green.

The lowest 2 scores will count as the team's score for that hole. The team with the lowest 18-hole score will win the event.

**Threesomes:**

The same rules of play above will apply to a threesome. However, the competitor listed first on the scorecard will hit two drives off the first hole played. The competitor listed second on the scorecard will hit two drives off the second hole played. The competitor listed third on the scorecard will hit two drives off the third hole played. On the fourth hole played, the order will start over with the competitor listed first on the scorecard. Threesomes will be able to choose from 4 drives and will choose the best positioned ball. Each competitor will then play their own ball into the hole. At the completion of the round, the team will receive the necessary number of blind draws in order to compete fairly.
